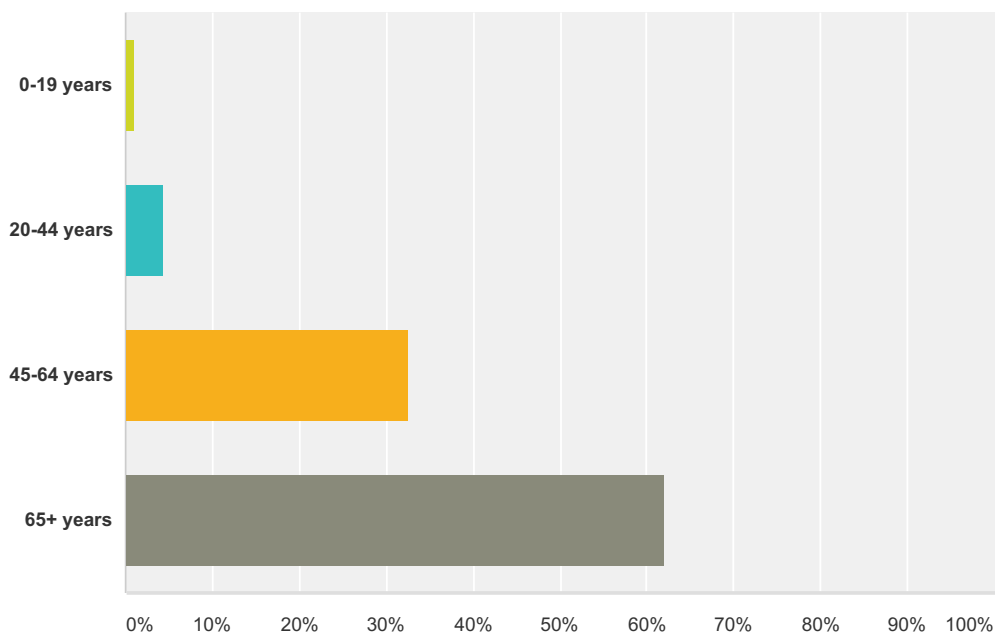

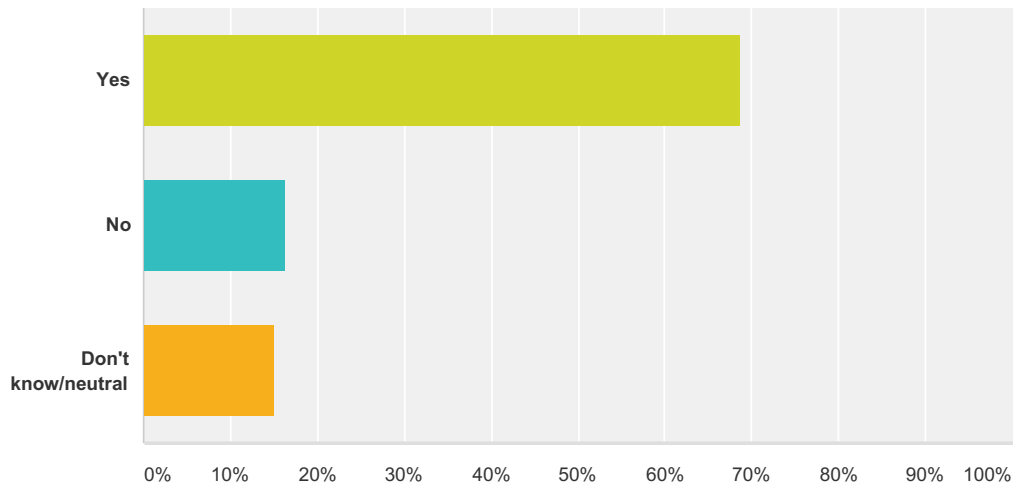

Q16 Do you think preserving large, undivided tracts of wetlands is important?

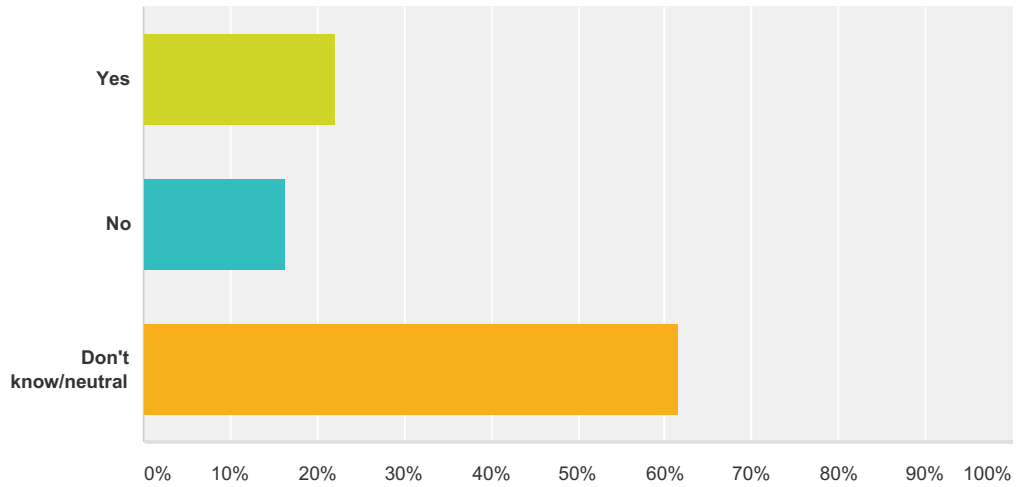

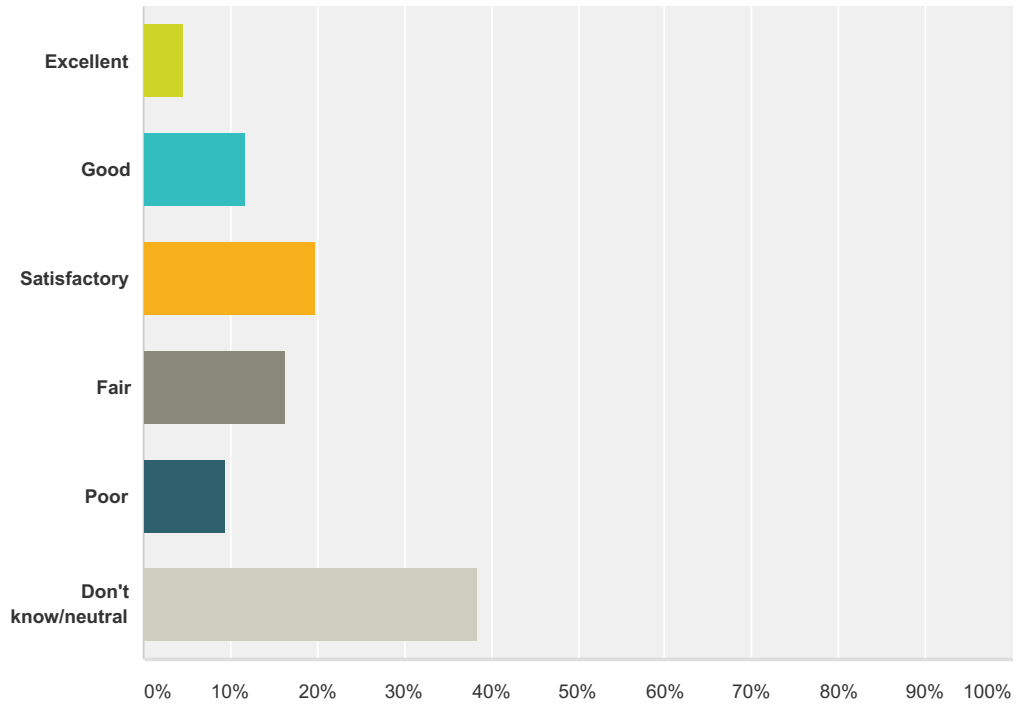

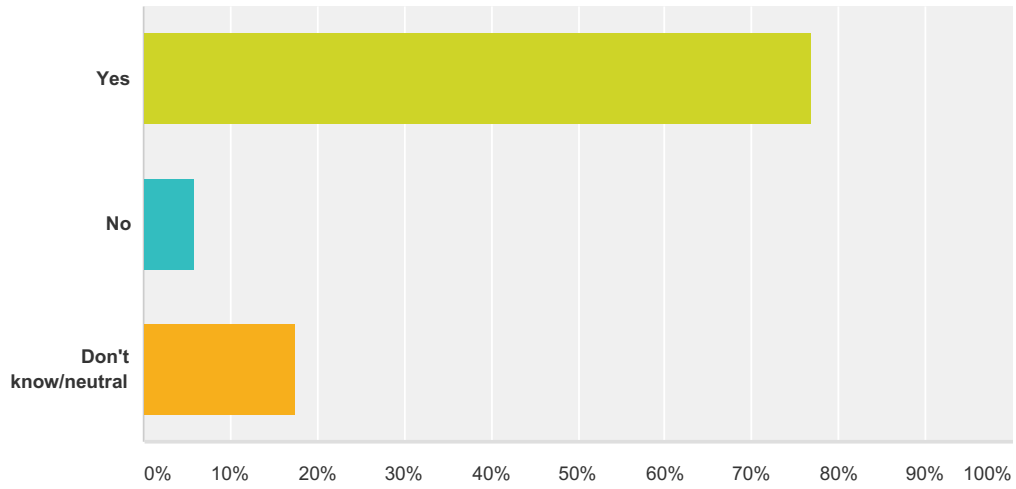

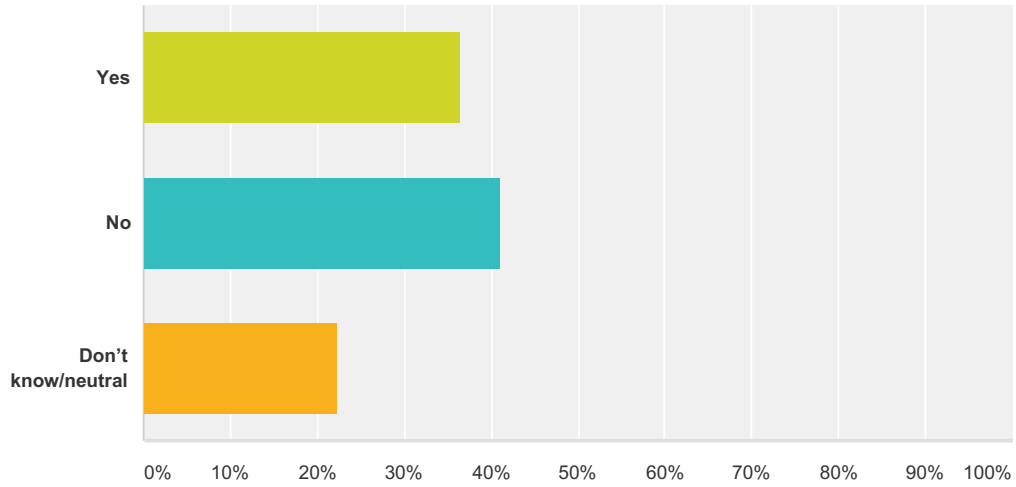

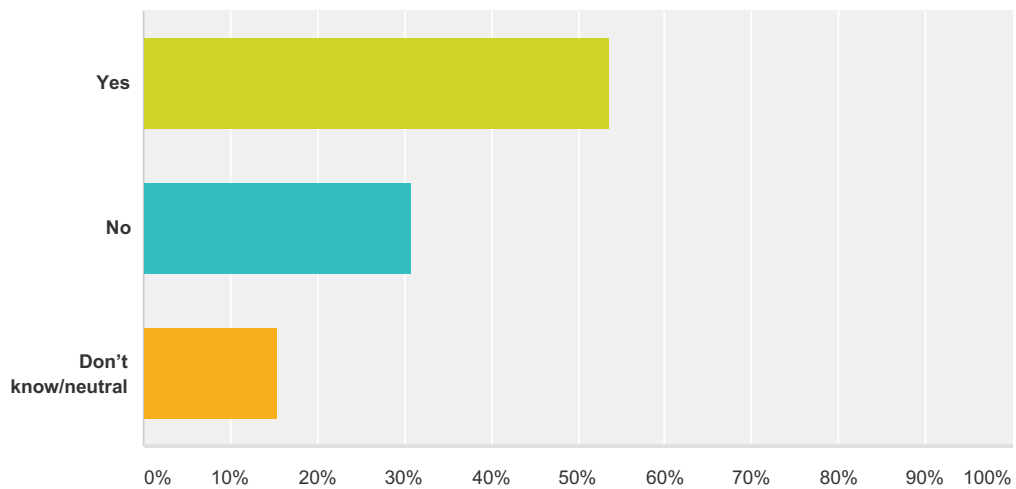

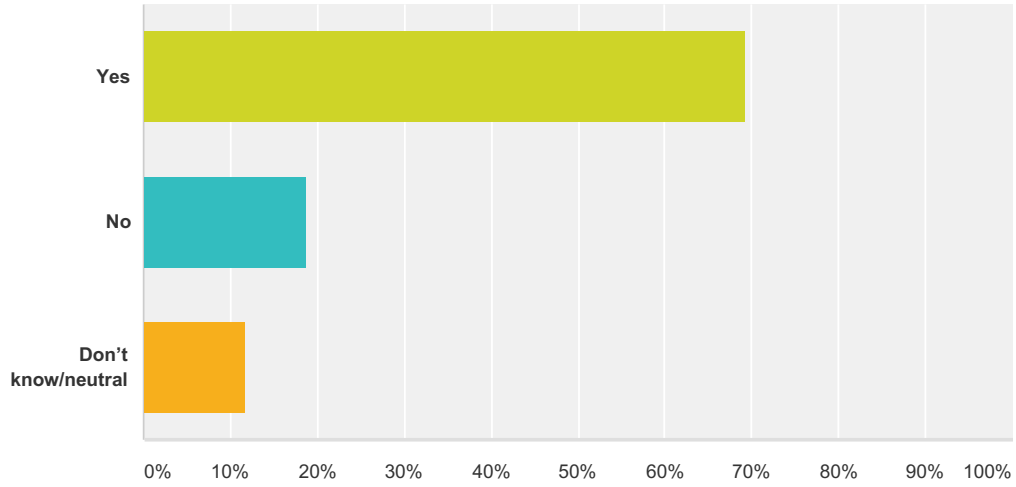

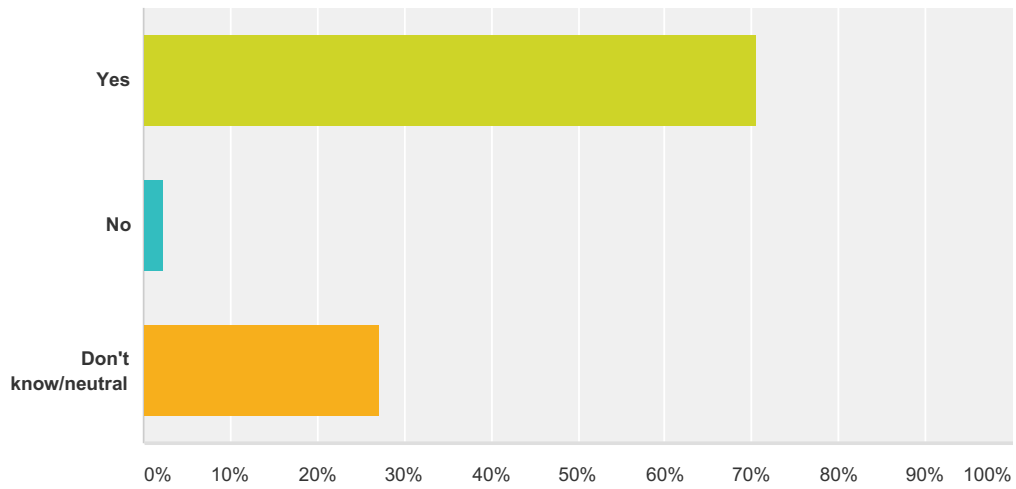

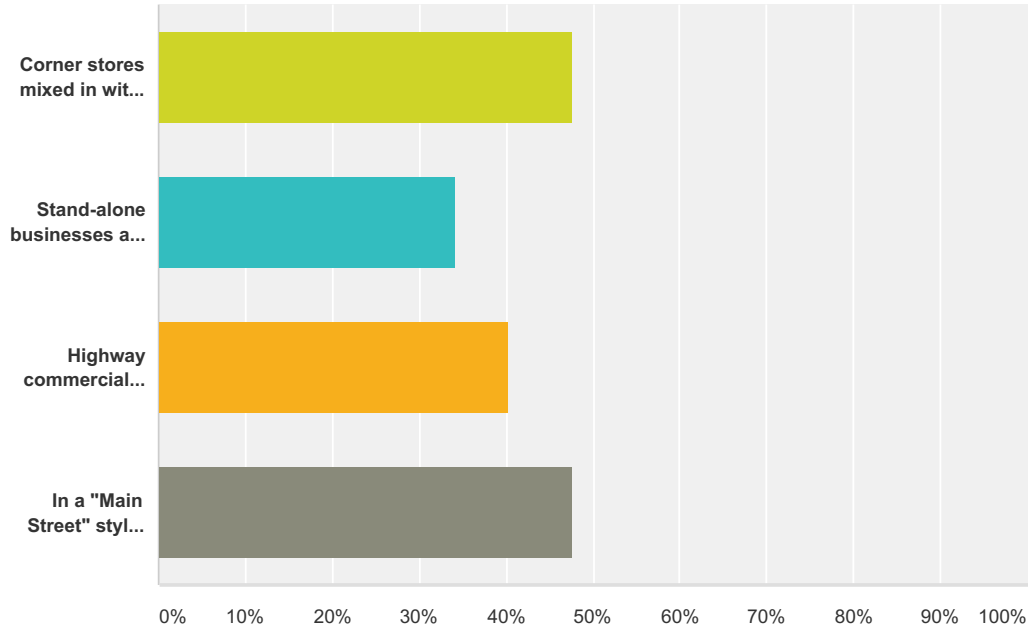

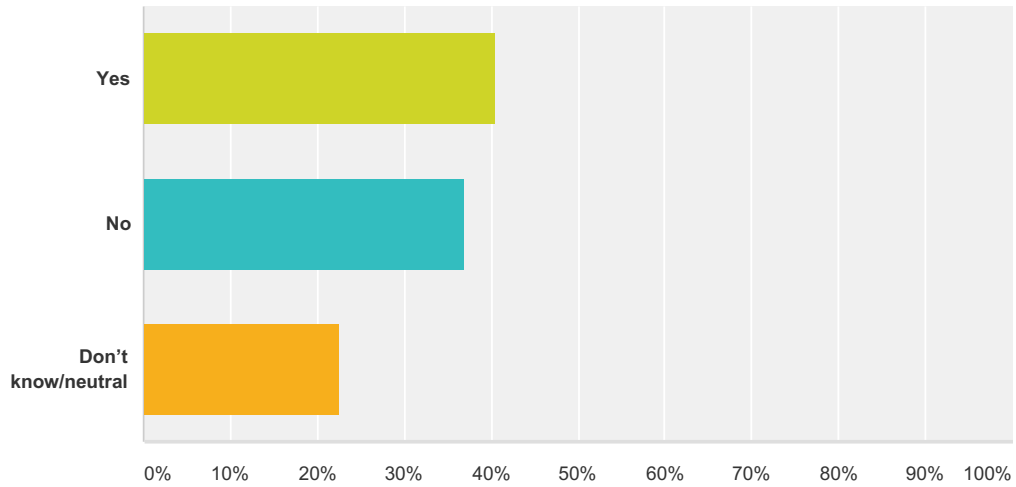

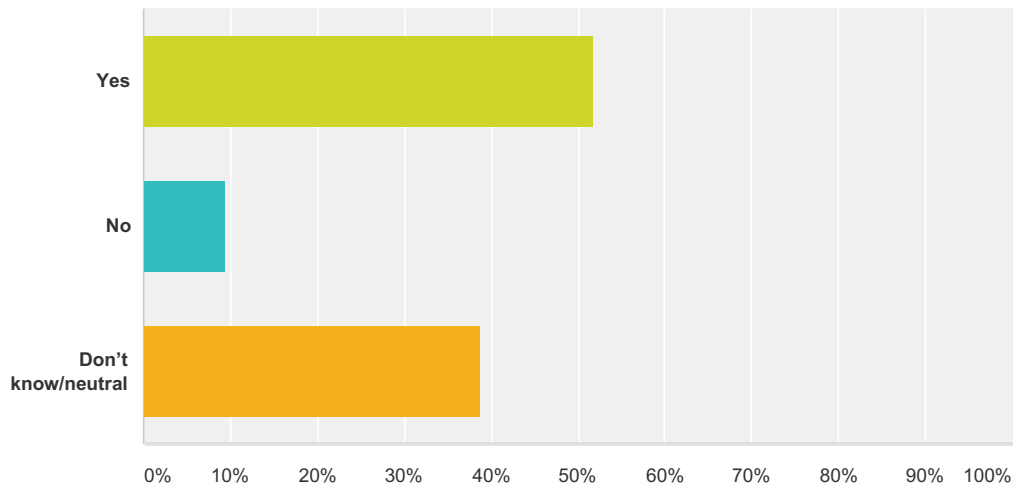

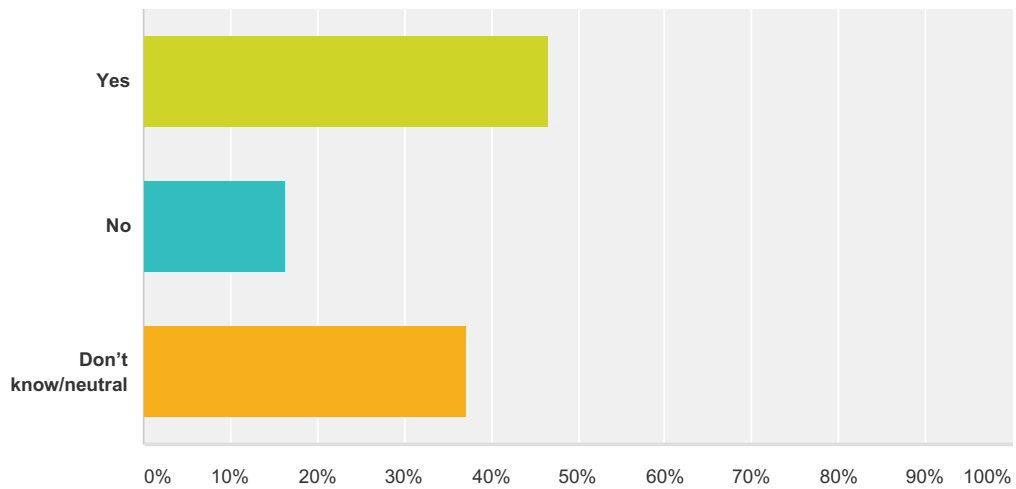

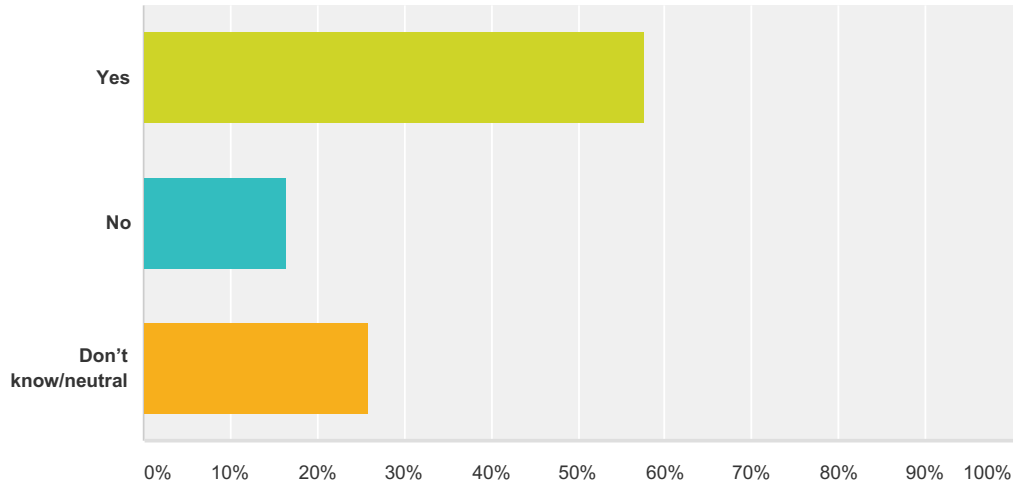

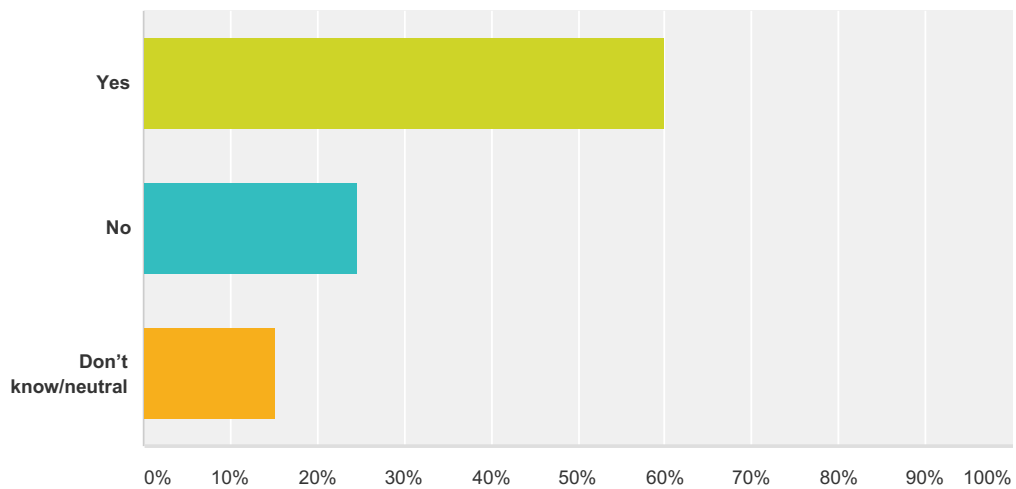
