Q10 In deciding to live or own property in the Township, how important was:

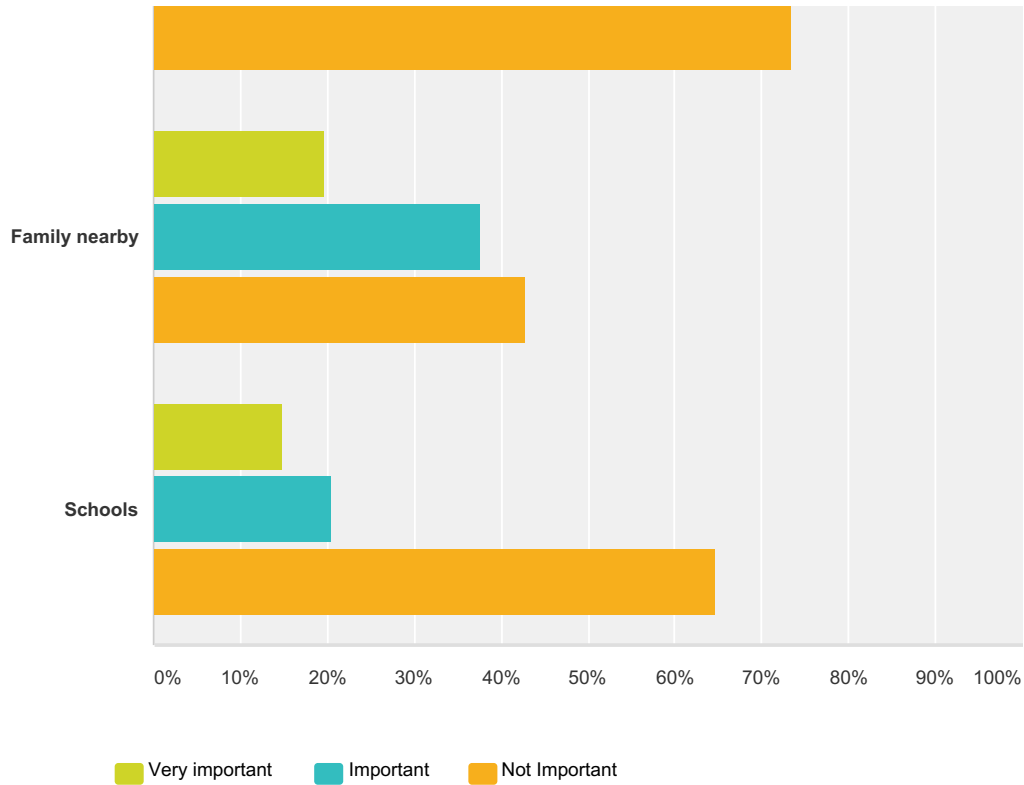

Q17 Do you feel Township government is responsive to your needs?

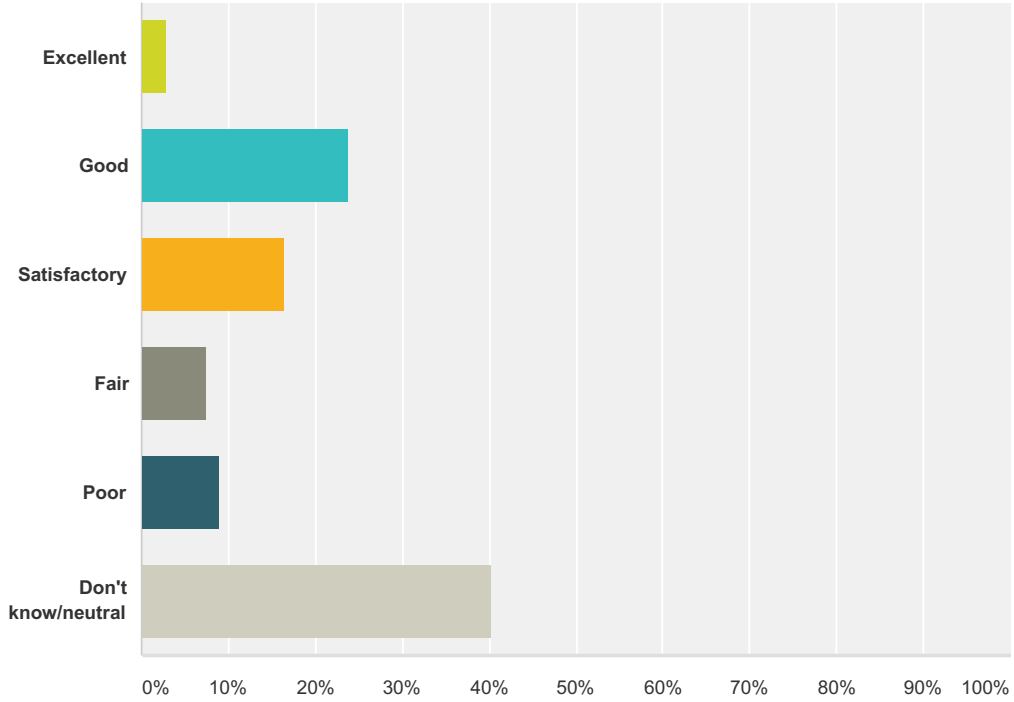

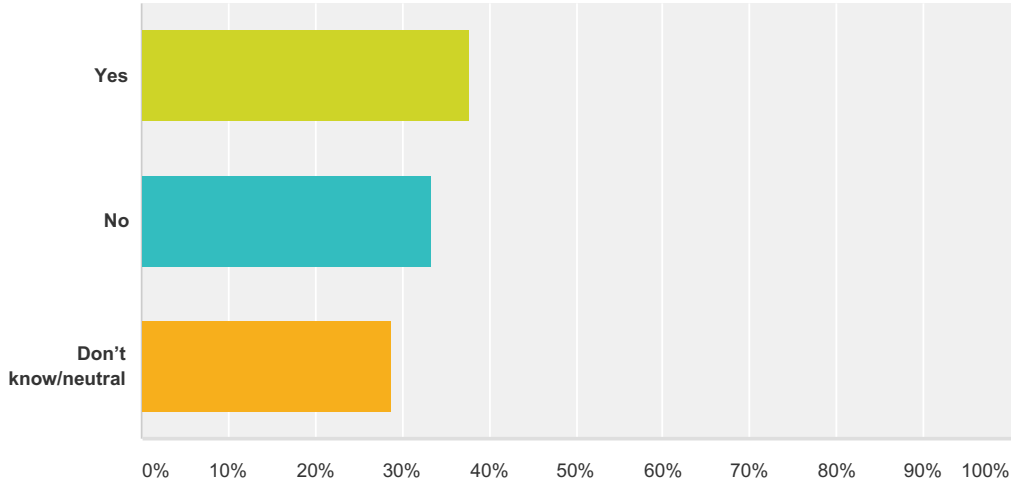

Q22 Should the Township encourage residential growth?

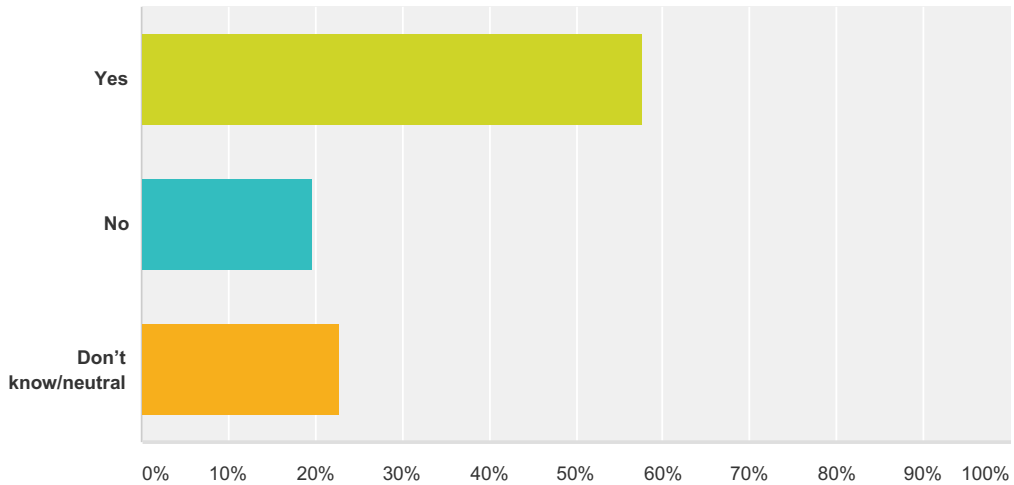

Q26 Should the Township encourage growth of small farms?

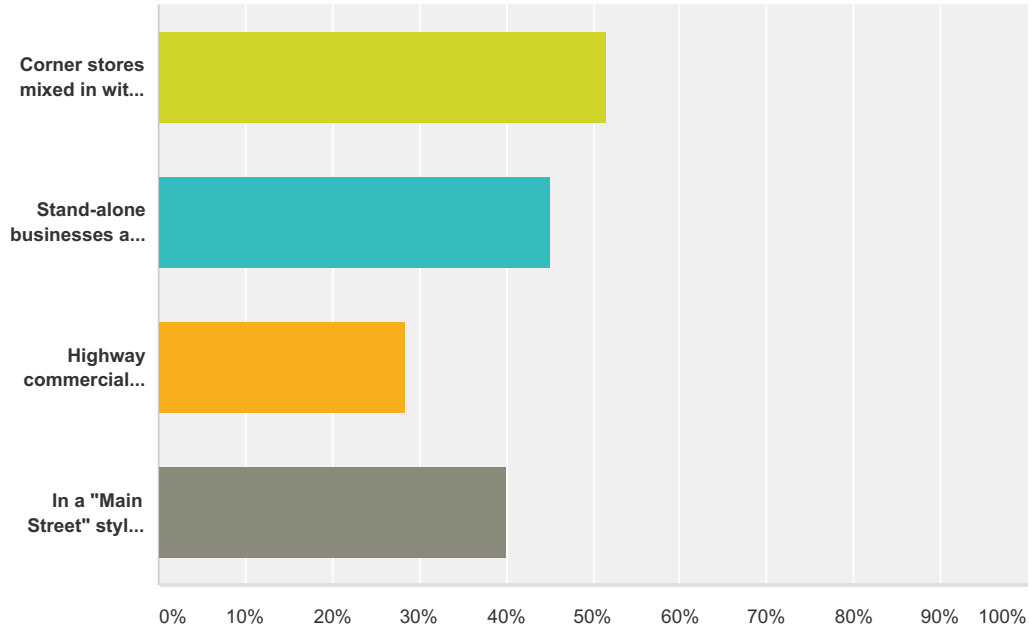

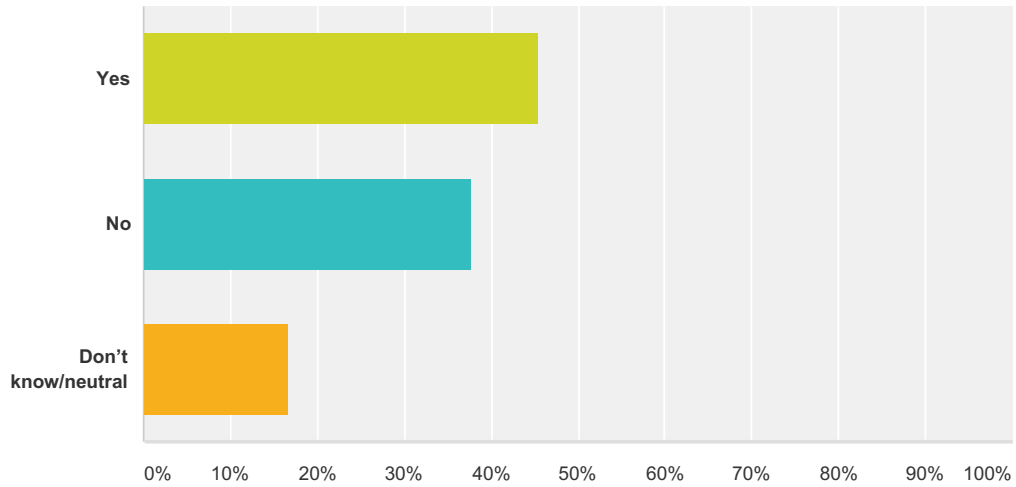

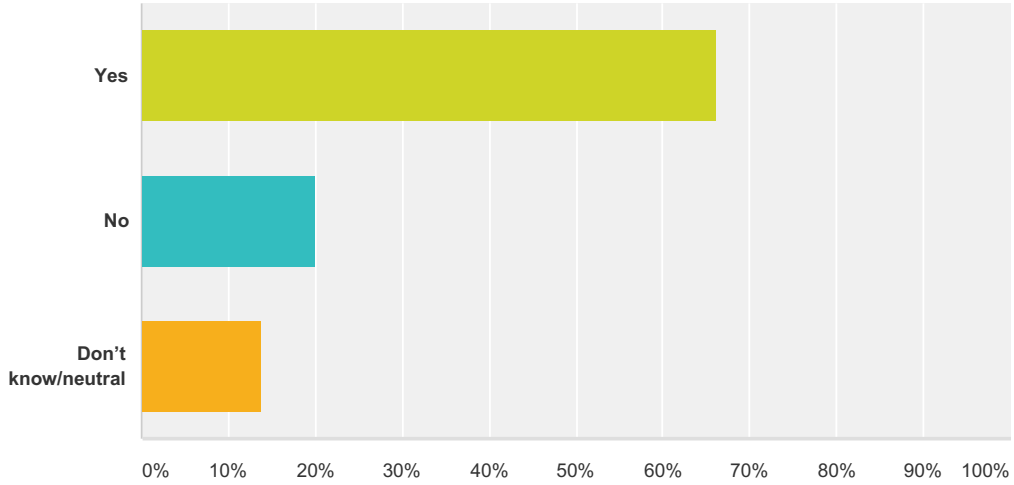

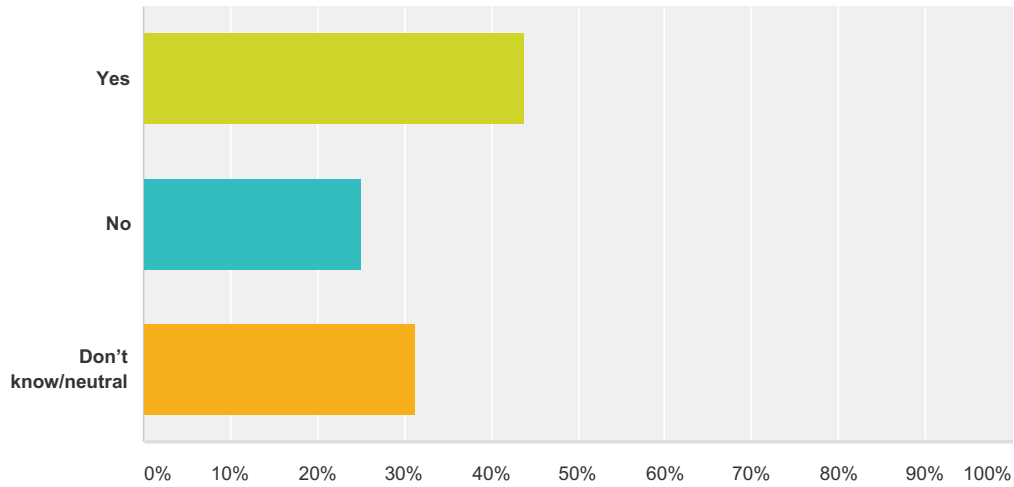
