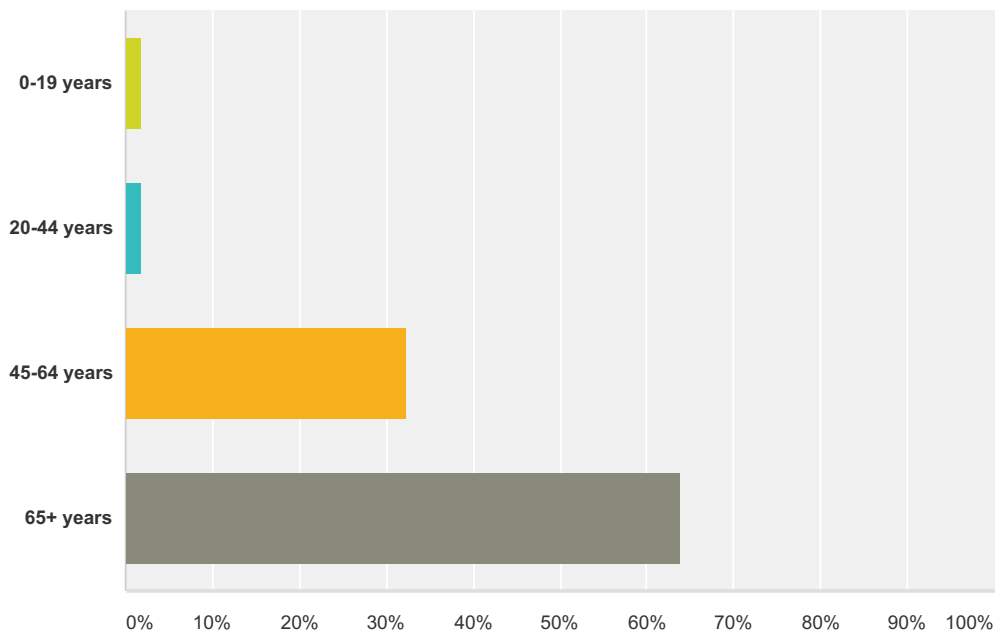

### Q10 In deciding to live or own property in the Township, how important was:

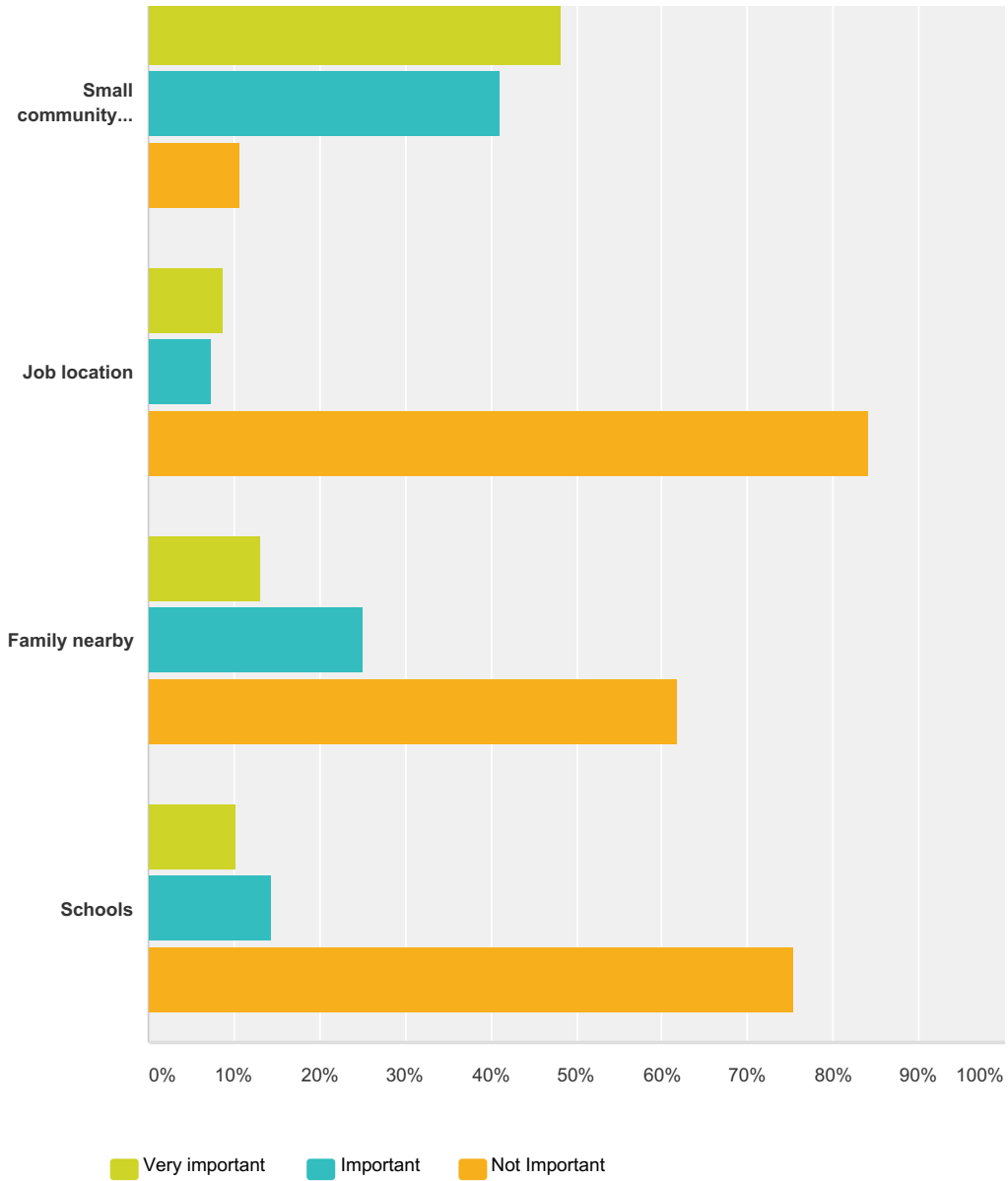

Non-Homestead properties are assessed at the absolute maximum millage (31.36640 mills). This raises the question of why I would have to drive to Oscoda to get rid of my garbage without having to pay \$3-5/bag. This is wrong any way you look at it. It is the epitome of taxation without representation. Or is it your expectation that we non-residents solicit a full-time refuse service for occasional use? Recycling appears to be non-existent as well.</p> <p>3. Many of the intersections around the South Shore area lack sufficient lighting. LED's are becoming more affordable, and are more cost efficient to operate. Property owners should not have illuminate these crossroads.</p> <p>4. 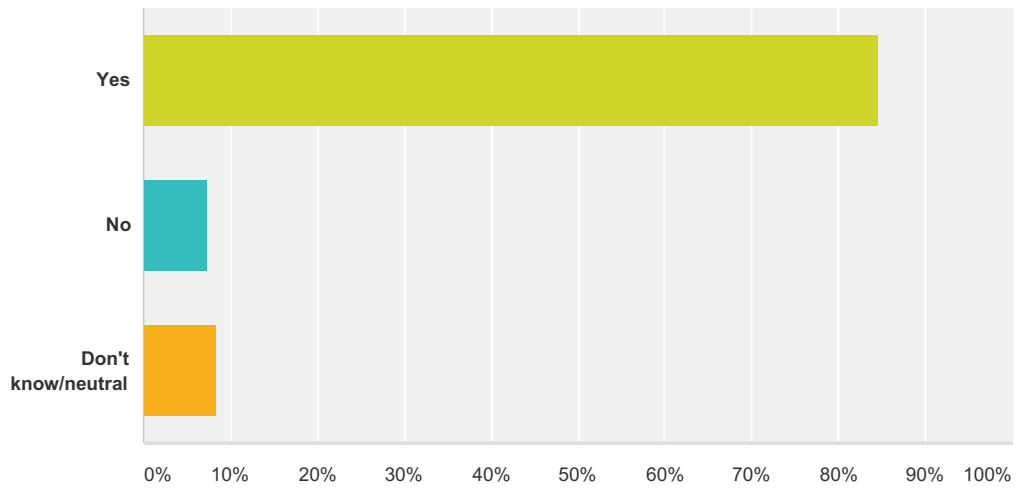

### Q15 Do you think preserving large, undivided tracts of forest is important?

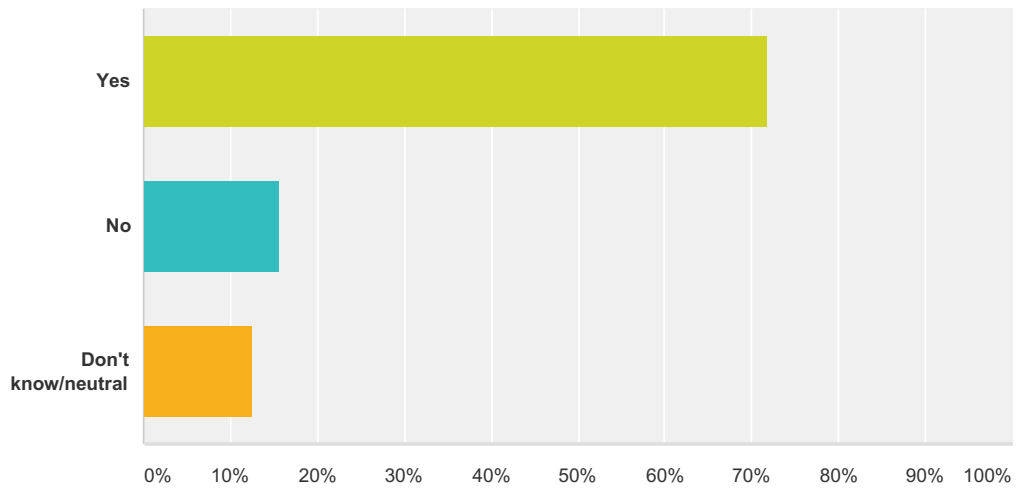

### Q16 Do you think preserving large, undivided tracts of wetlands is important?

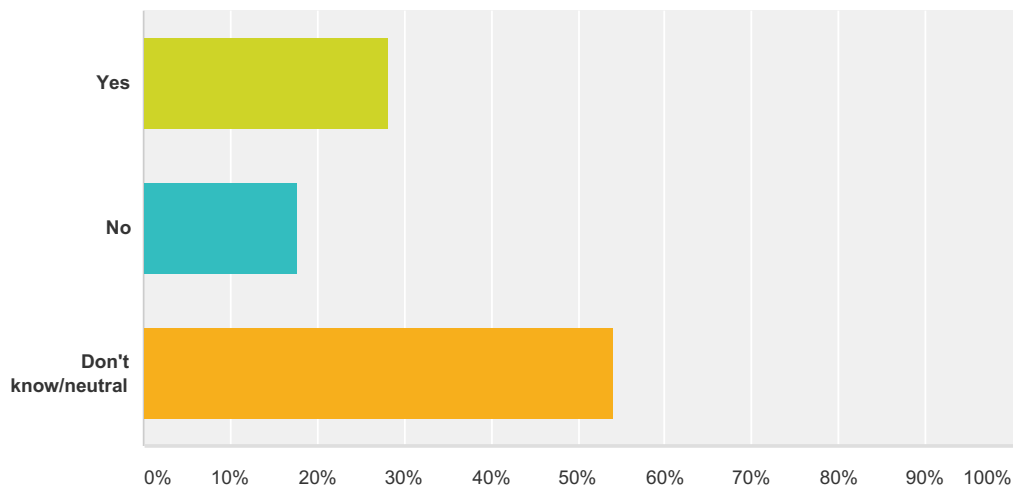

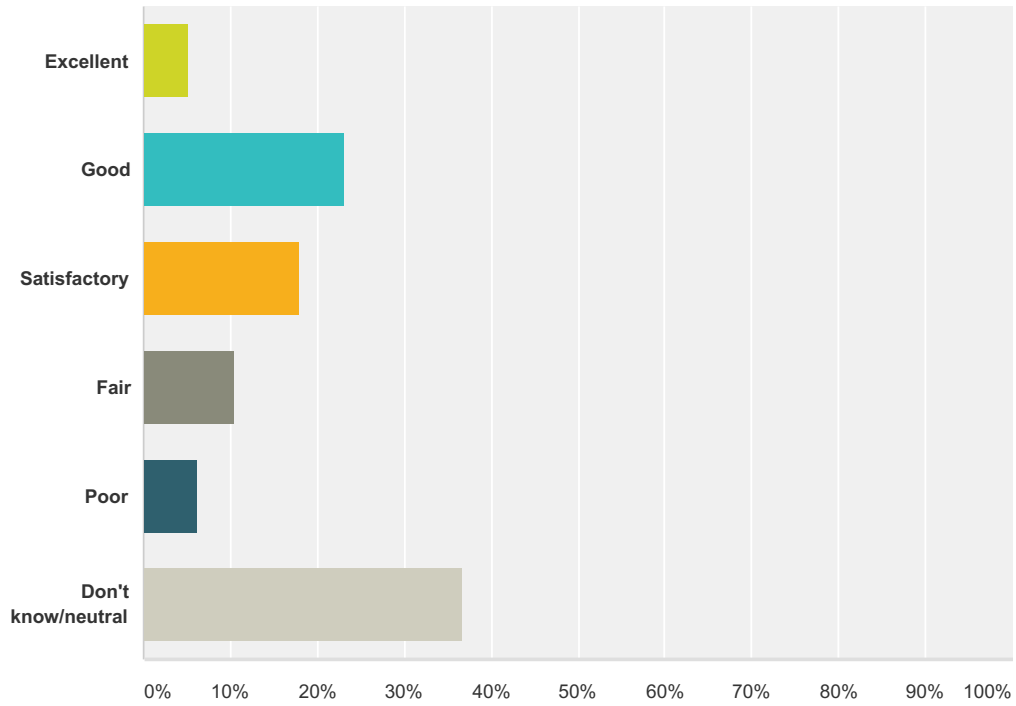

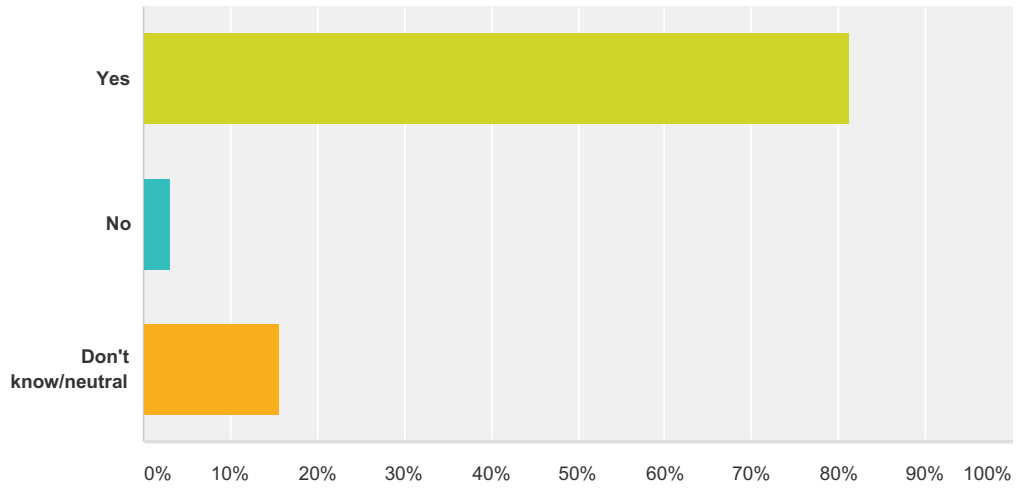

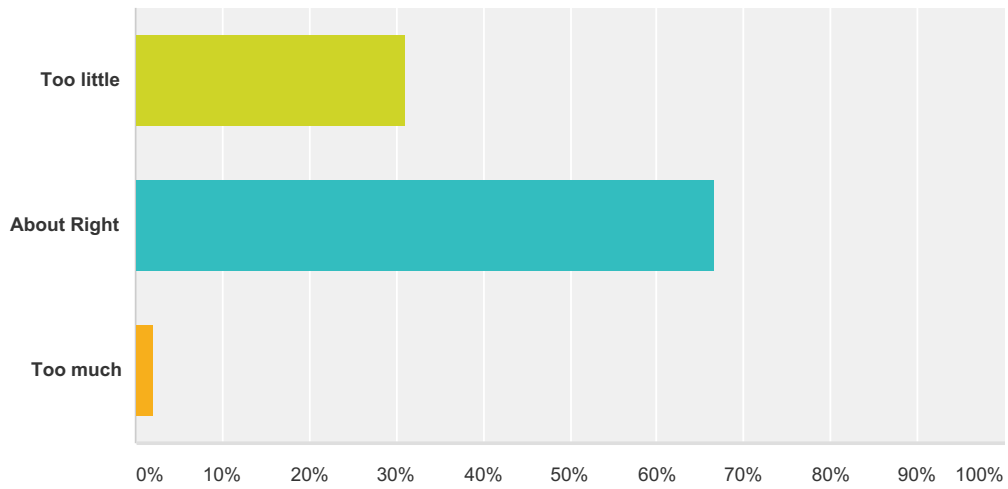

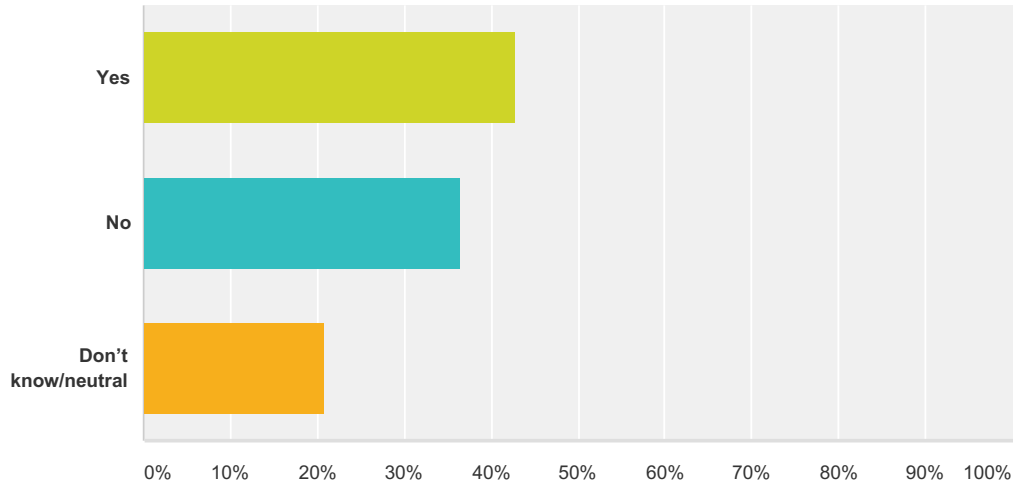

### Q22 Should the Township encourage residential growth?

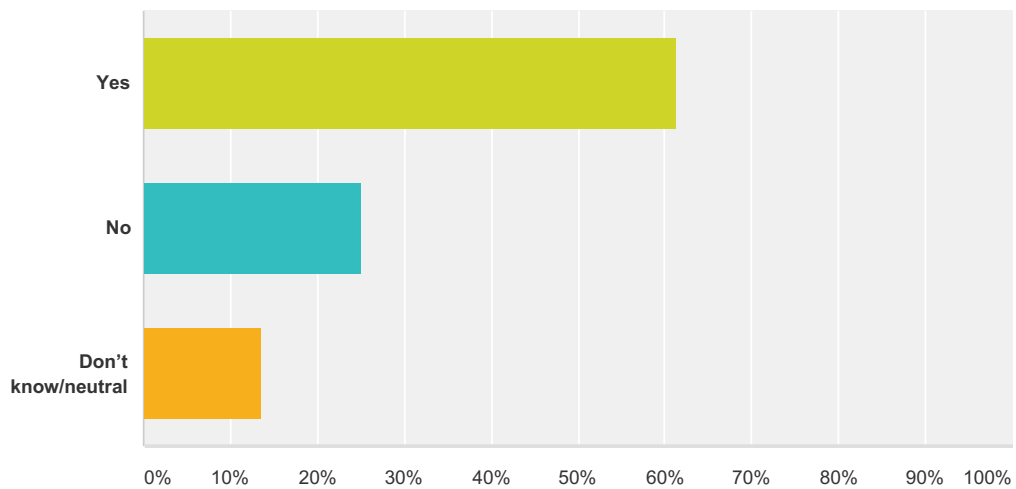

### Q26 Should the Township encourage growth of small farms?

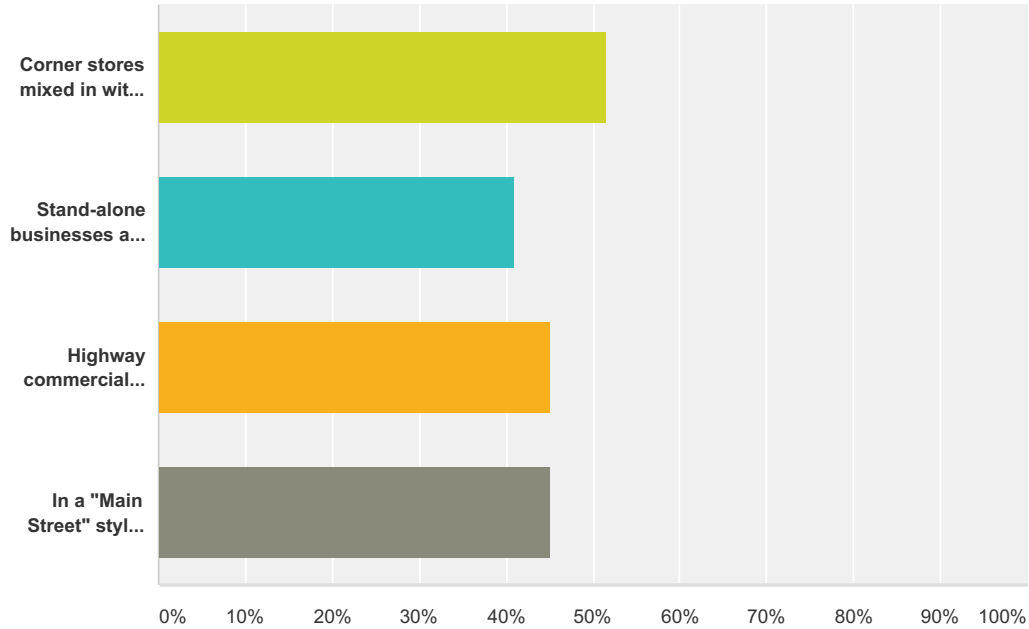

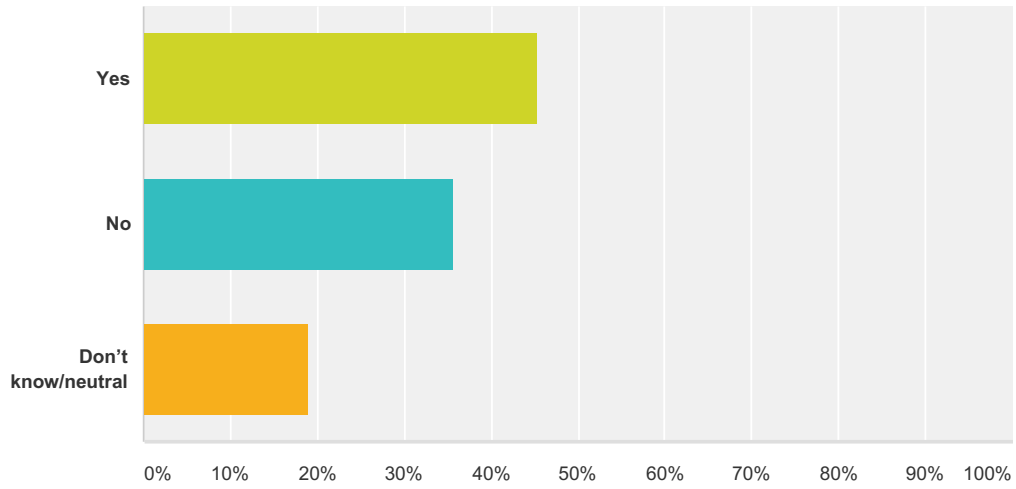

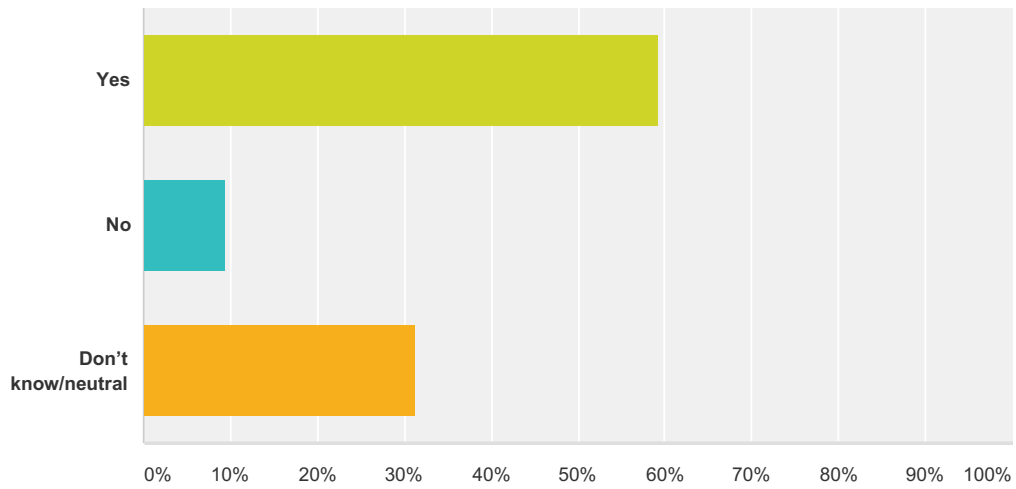

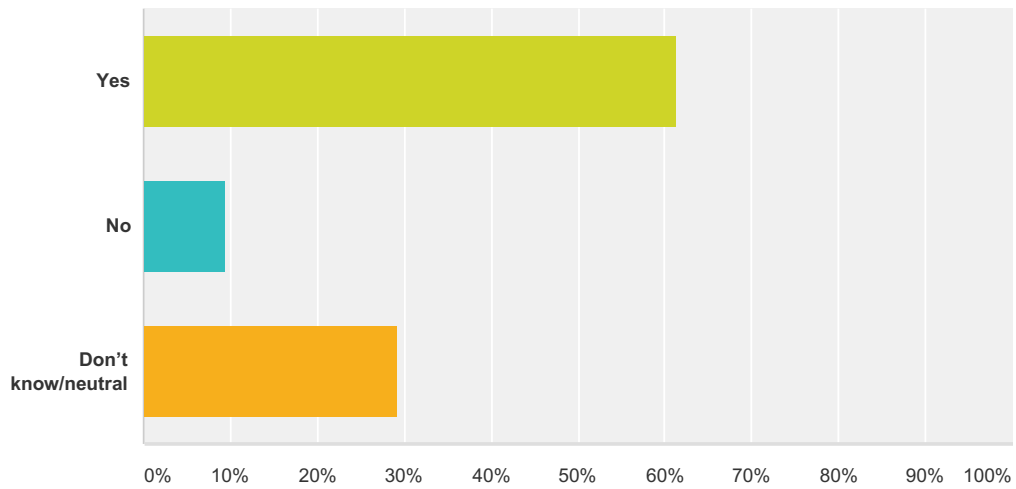

### Q33 Are you satisfied with fire protection in your township?

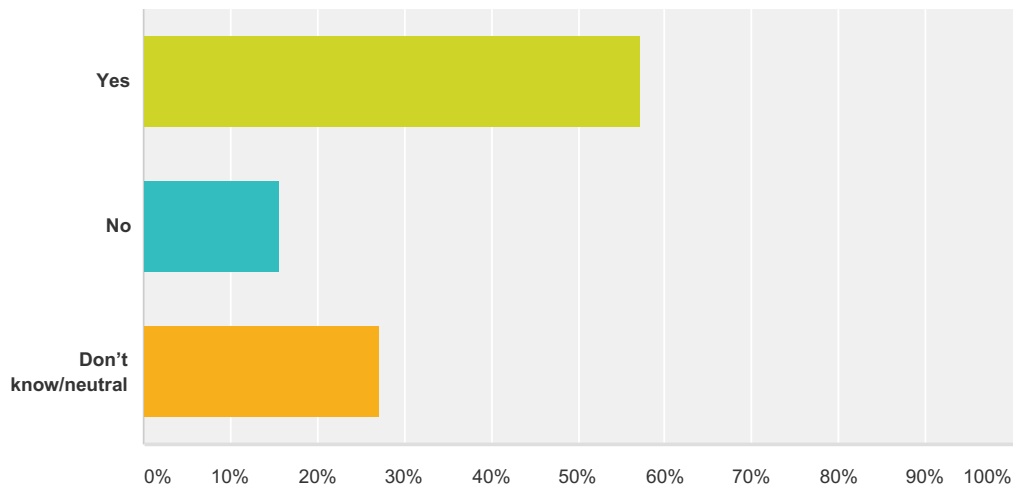

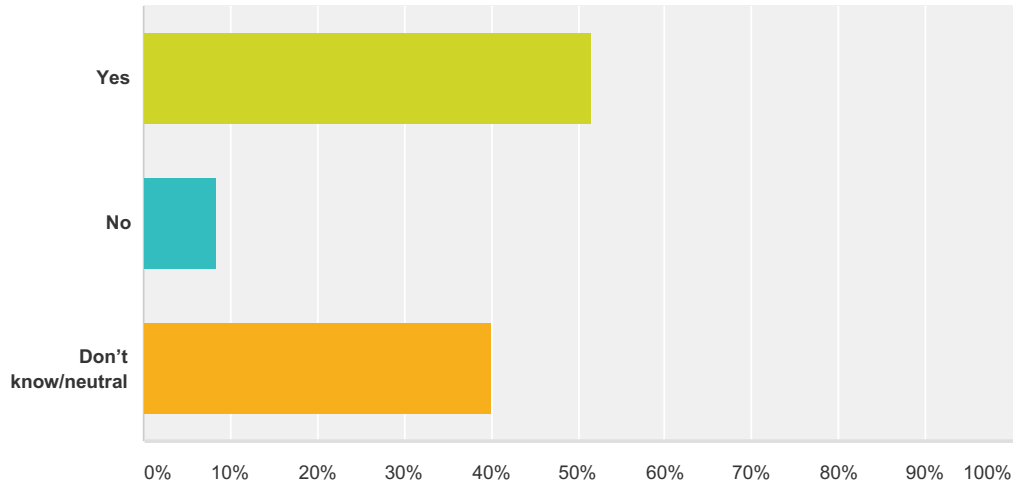

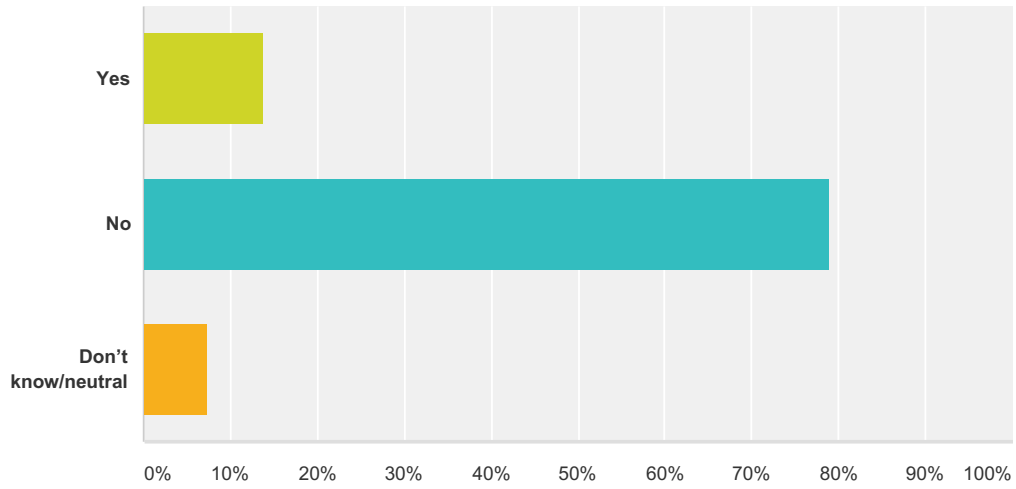

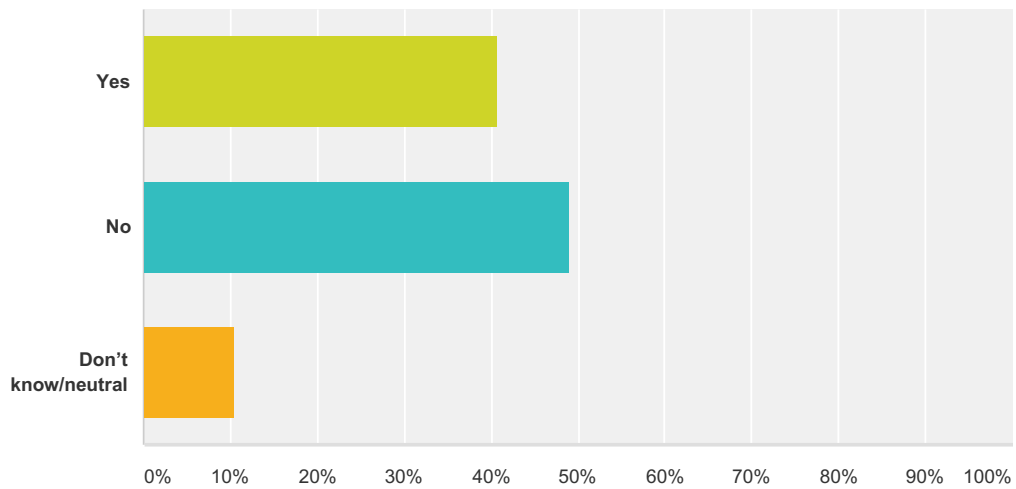

### Q37 Do you feel that high speed internet access in your township is adequate?

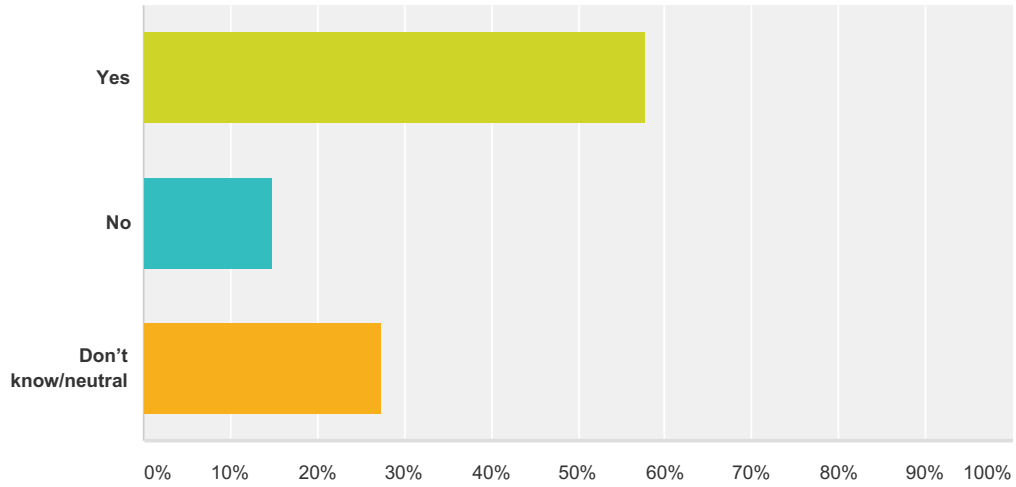

### Q38 Do you think the Township should be involved in economic development?

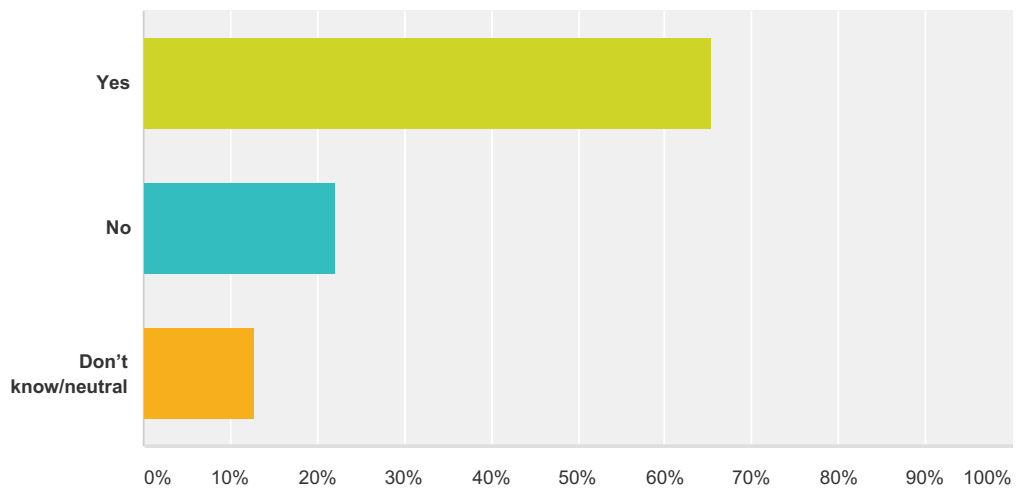

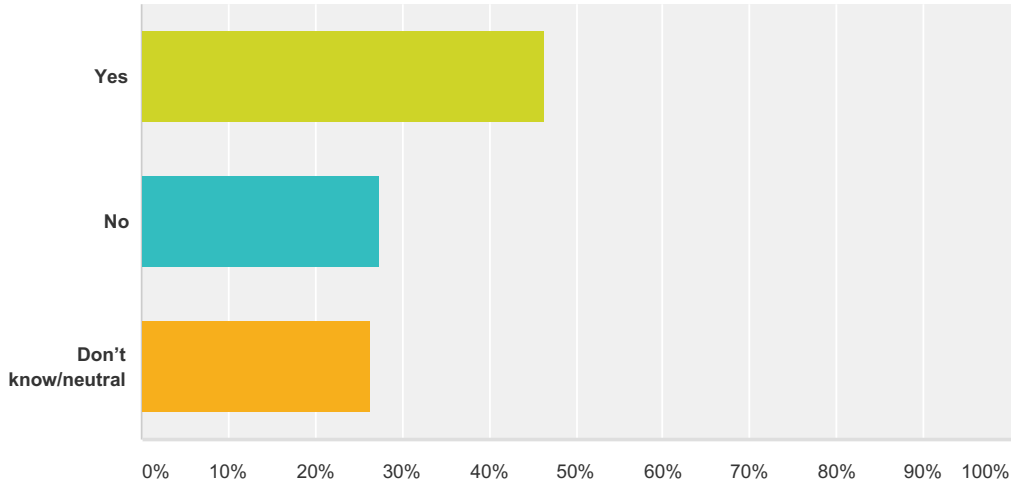
