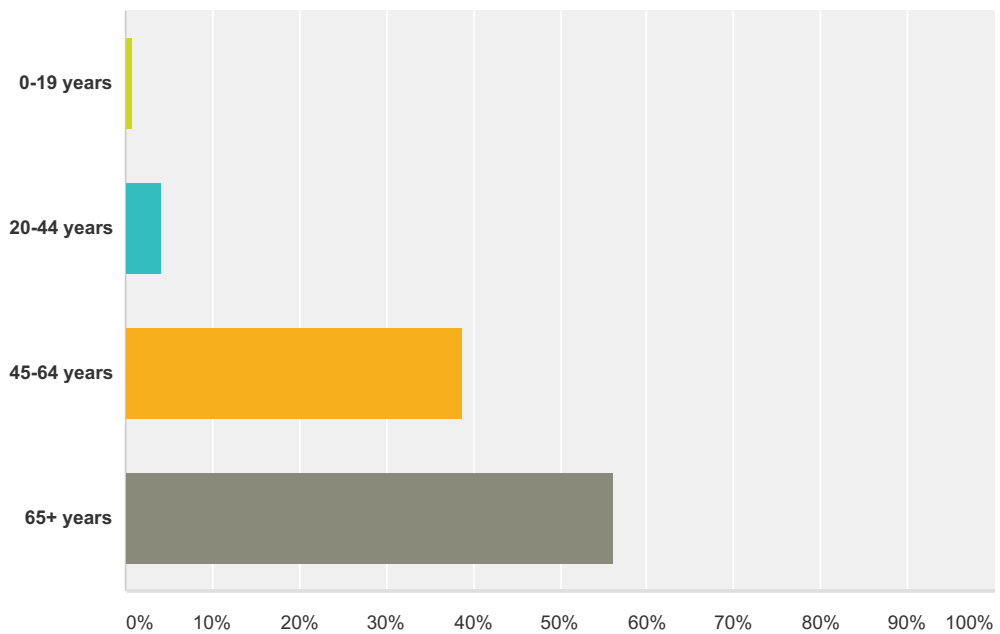

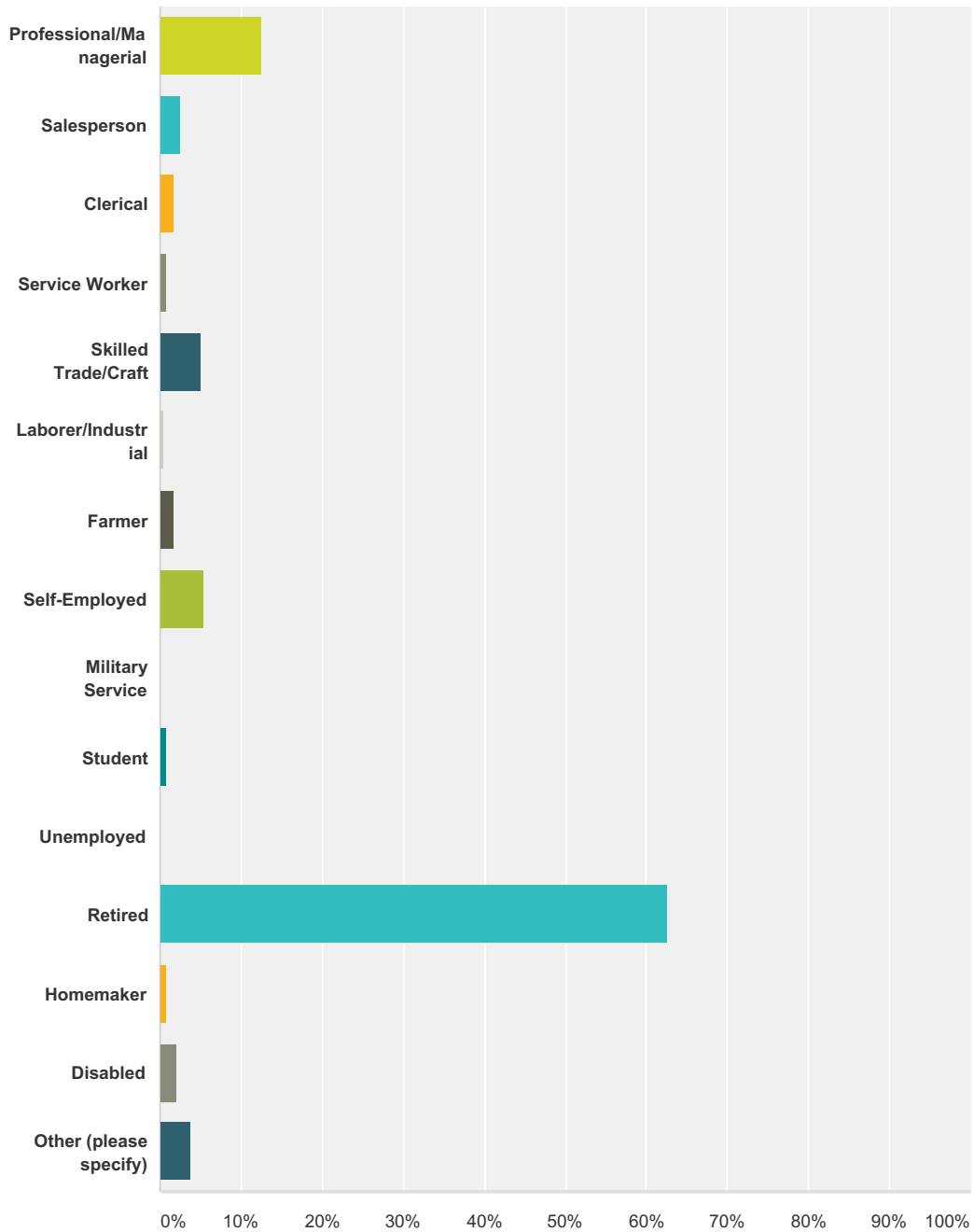

Q10 In deciding to live or own property in the Township, how important was:

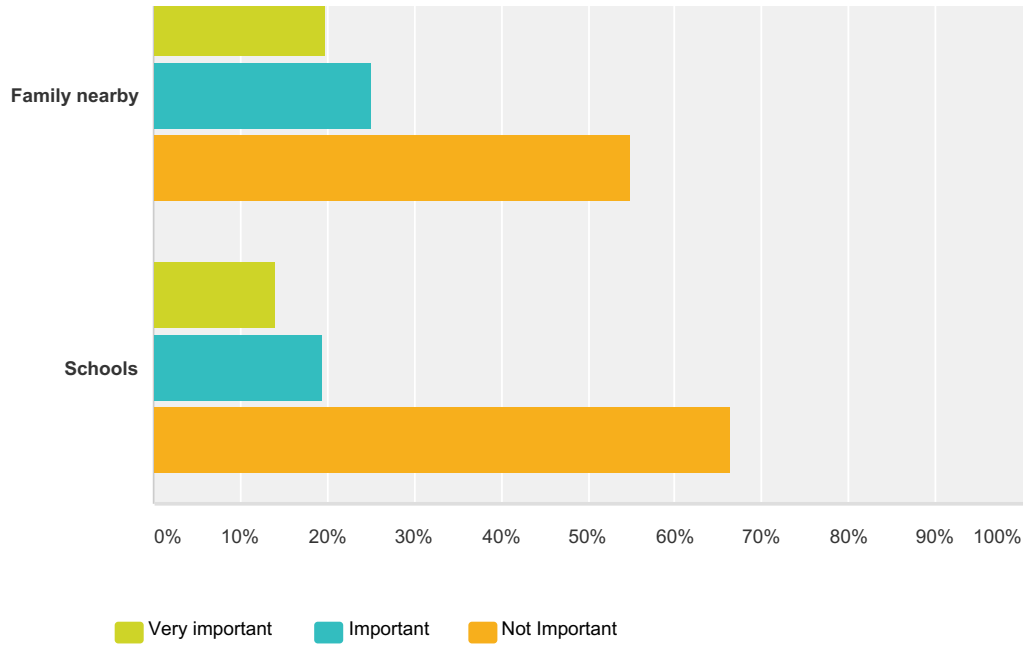

Q12 In your opinion, how important are the following resources to the future of your Township?

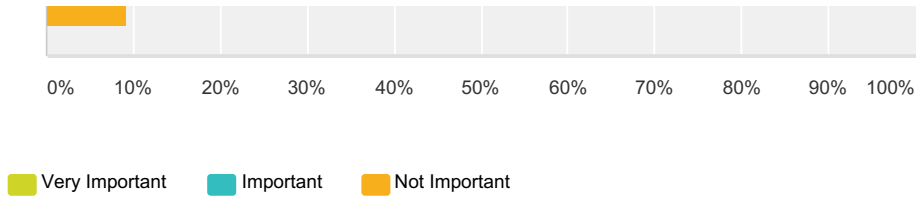

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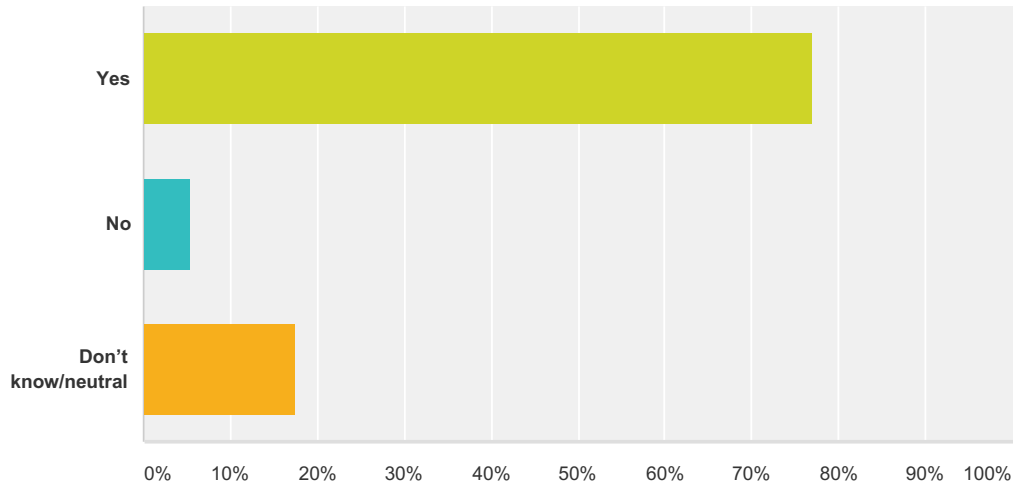

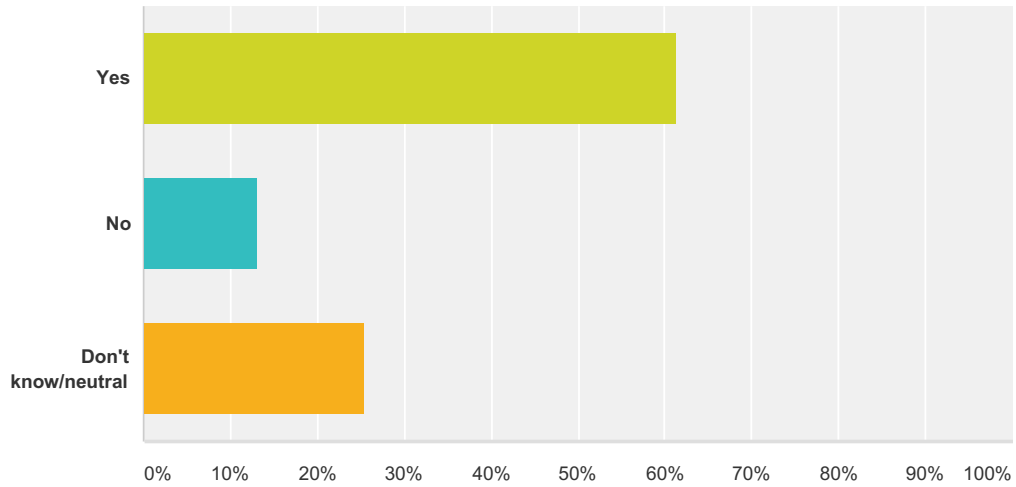

Q14 Do you think preserving large, undivided tracts of farmland is important?

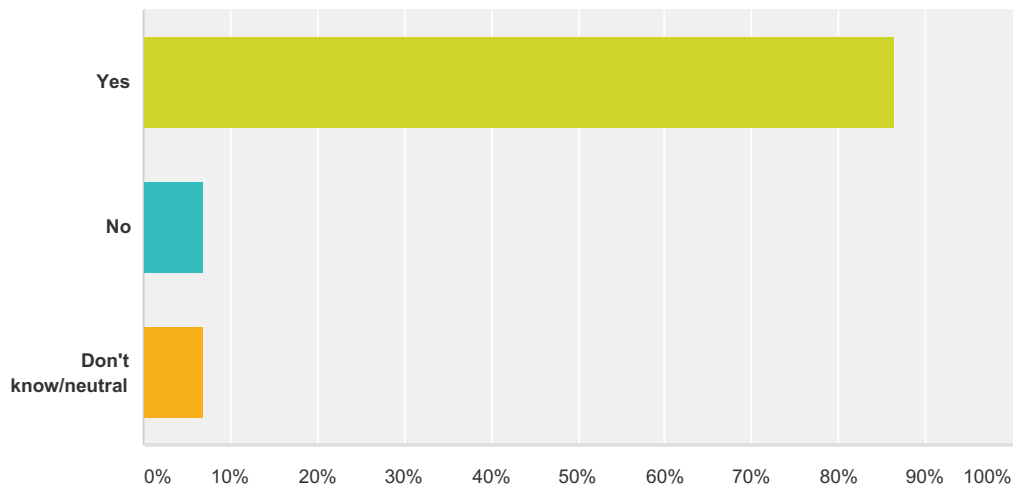

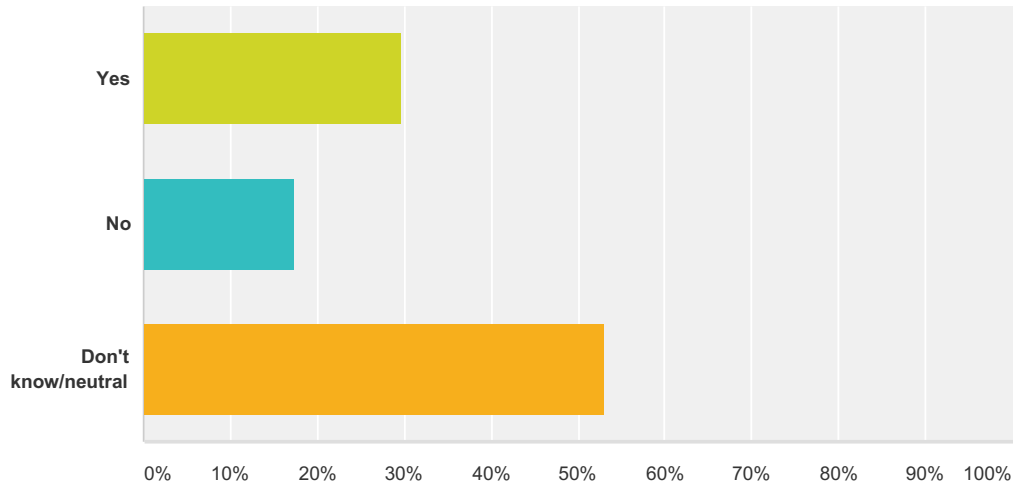

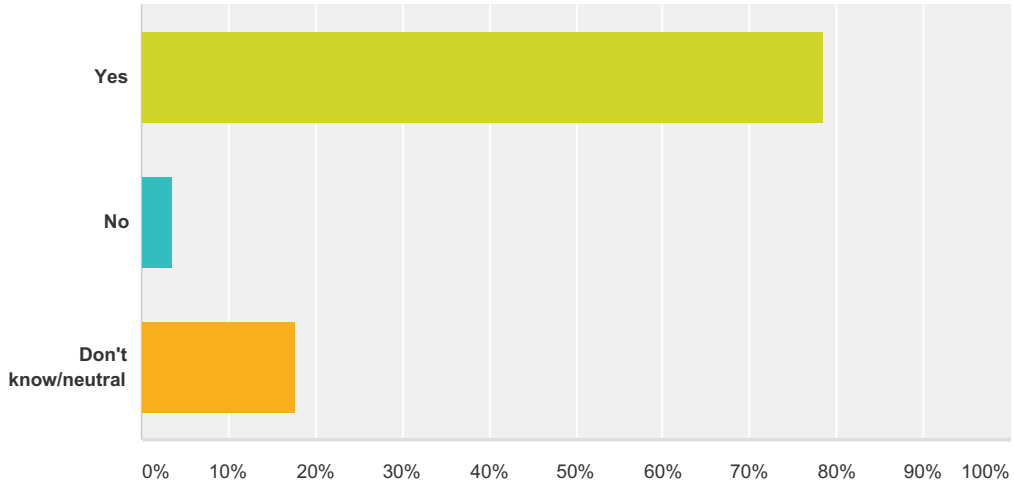

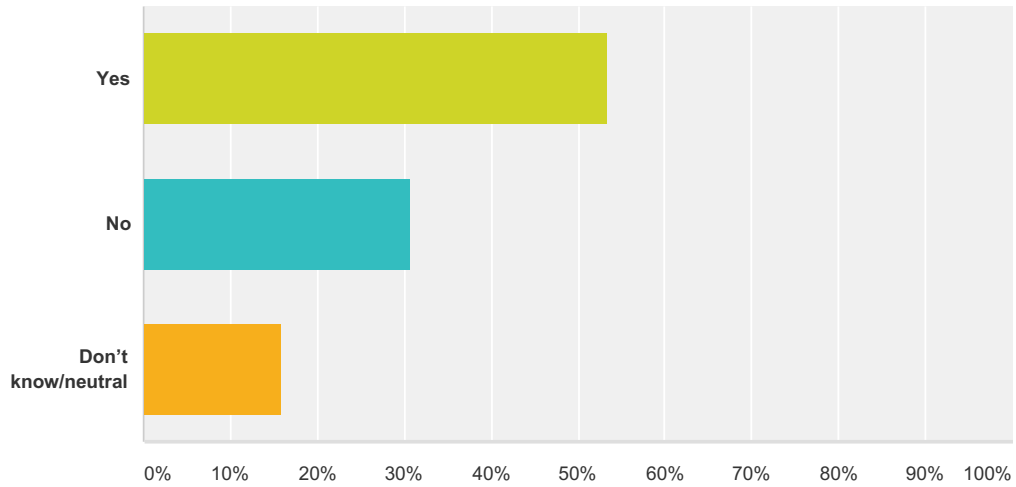

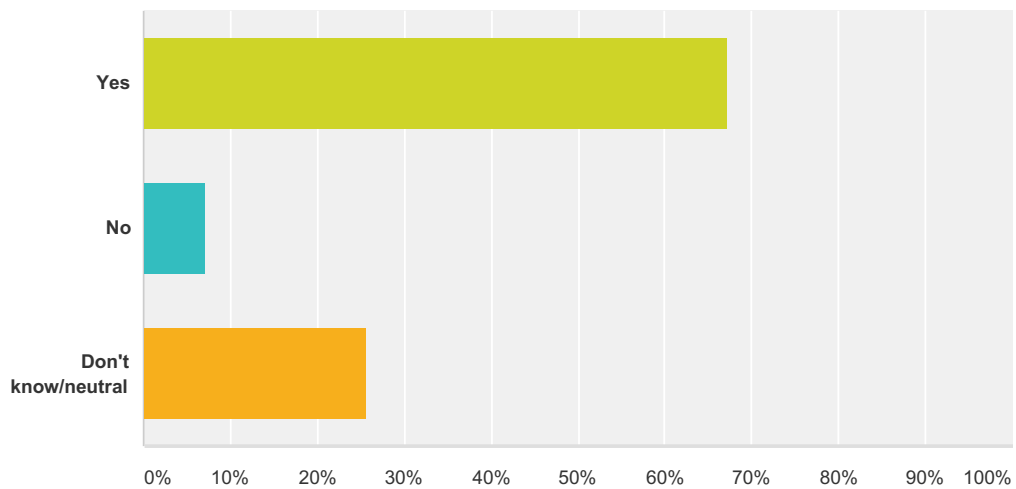

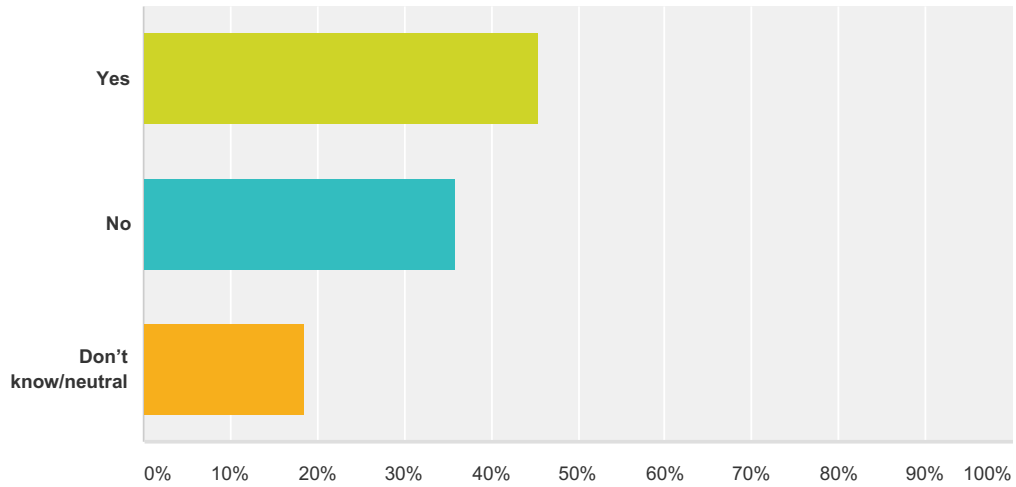

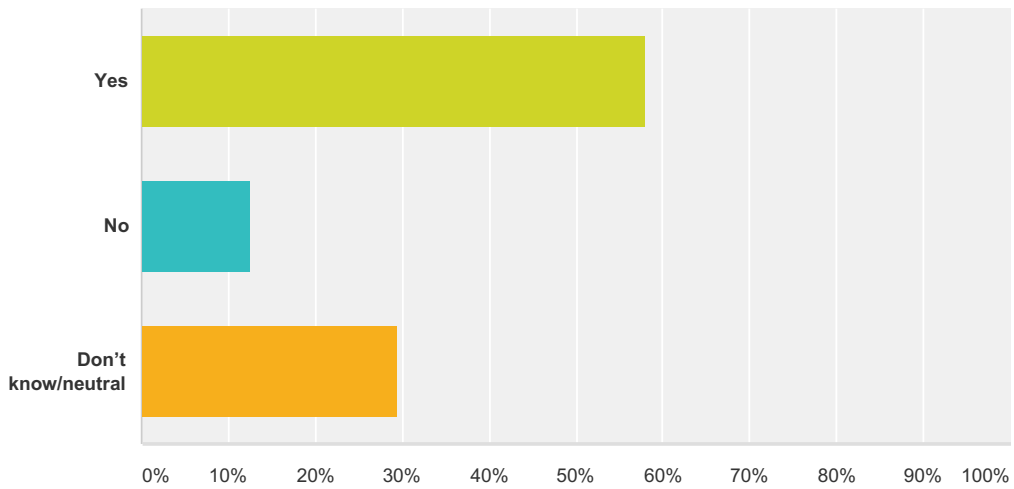

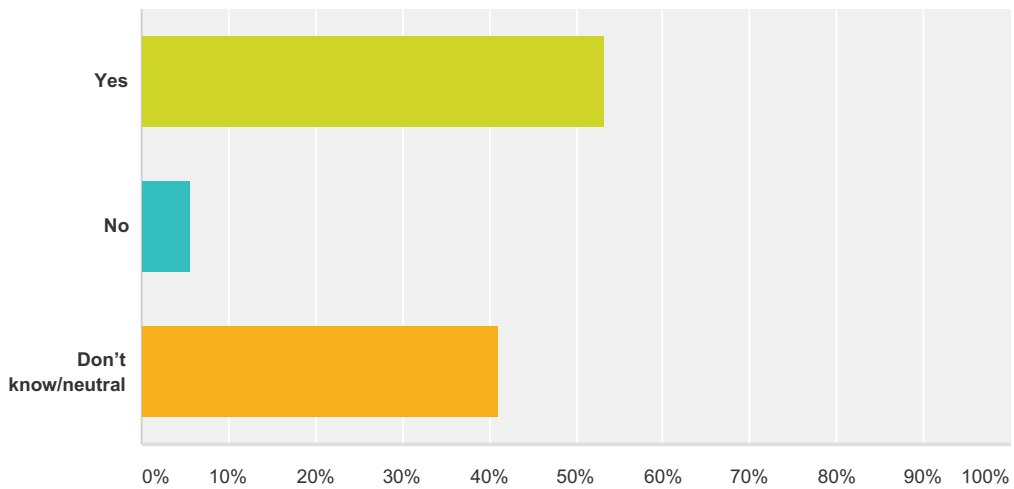

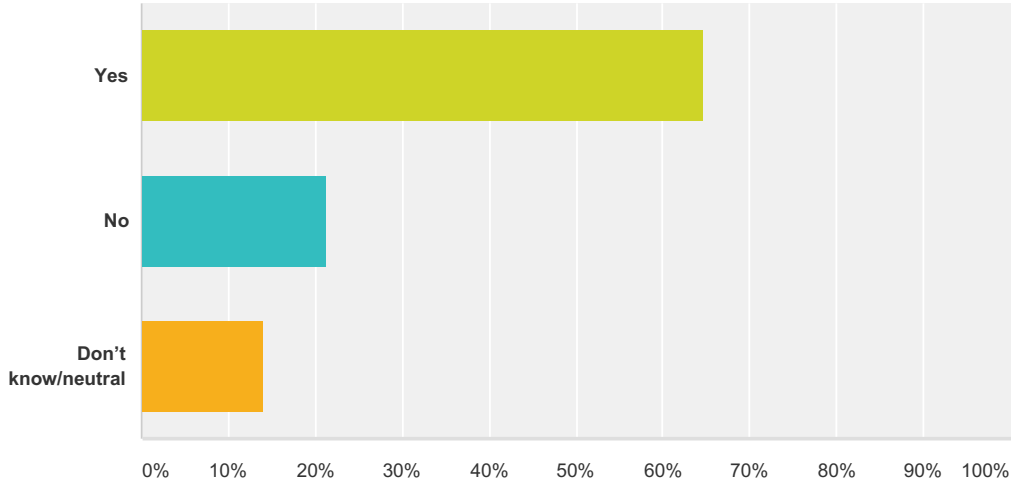

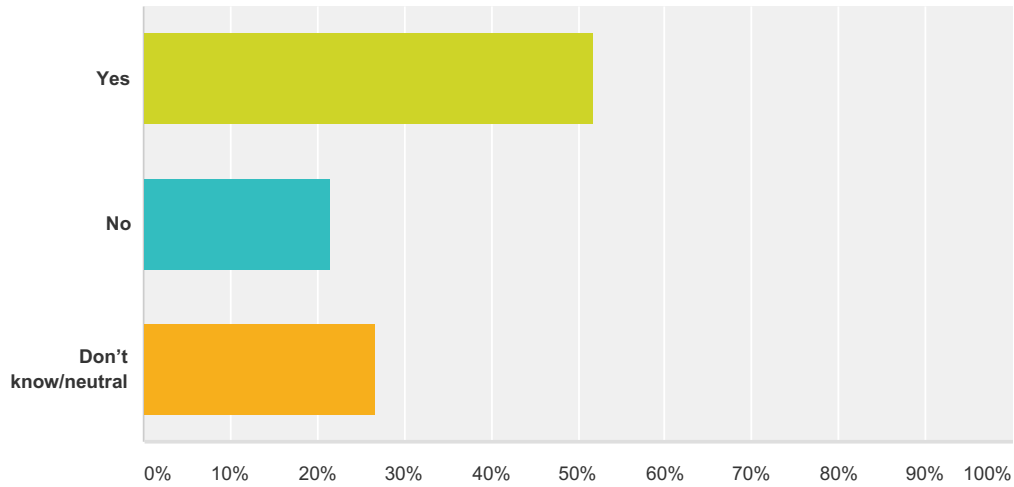
